

DEAR FELLOW ABOLITIONISTS,

If you were tracking with Exodus Cry in 2020, you know how it was a year of viral exposure and exponential growth, thanks to the global Traffickinghub campaign. We took on the "world's biggest porn site" for hosting videos of rape, trafficking, and child sexual abuse—and their empire began to crumble. We're thrilled to report that the tidal wave of momentum we gained in 2020 has crashed onto 2021, continuing to bring predatory porn giants to their knees.

One of the world's biggest payment processors, Mastercard, significantly raised the bar of accountability for porn sites, instituting new rules requiring robust age and consent verification of all individuals depicted in porn globally, and a process for illegal content to be removed quickly.

Pornhub's largest competitor, xHamster, removed their download button, deleted huge numbers of unverified content from the website, and disallowed anonymous uploading. Just like Pornhub, xHamster is now being investigated for hosting real rape, trafficking, revenge porn, and child sexual abuse content, and is also being sued by the victims of these crimes.

But the Traffickinghub wins don't stop there. In March 2021, we rallied the support of our Instagram followers to flood Roku's social media pages and demand the platform remove the Pornhub channel from their streaming sites. They got the message. In the beginning of November, Roku announced they would ban Pornhub and all other porn channels from their platform.

These decisions are the direct result of your actions! We are so incredibly thankful for the way you, our dedicated supporters, have rallied together to bring substantial change.

We also released our third feature film, Raised on Porn in September, which exposes the ways pornography has become the new sex education for children and unpacks the dangerous lifelong implications of this global phenomenon.

Released exclusively on YouTube, the film quickly surpassed one million views and received 9/10 stars on IMDb.

We had the honor of directly reaching out to victims of trafficking and serving many survivors through trauma-informed therapy so that they can begin a journey of transformative healing and build beautiful new lives. In total, we were able to reach 346 women in 2021 thanks to the generosity of our supporters.

Whether it's the history-shaping wins happening through our global campaigns or the beautifully transformed lives of individuals, all of this is a testament to the power of our collective voice. We are beyond grateful for every person who has joined us in this fight. Together, we're watching the world change as the giants fall.

Trafficking hub

After the mindblowing success of the 2020 Traffickinghub campaign, 2021 brought several massive wins for the movement, building on the momentum of the previous year. These wins came as a result of our collective push to boldly and publicly expose how Pornhub was profiting off of content featuring actual cases of rape, trafficking, and child sexual abuse.

Mastercard's unprecedented new policies disrupt exploitative porn

In December of 2020, Mastercard ceased all payment processing on Pornhub. In April 2021, the credit card company took it a step further, announcing new measures to prevent illegal adult content on porn sites everywhere.

Mastercard now requires robust age verification and documented consent of all individuals depicted in porn on sites globally, as well as an in-depth process for illegal content to be removed quickly. This compels banks to ensure the legitimate consent practices of their merchants before processing any payments.

With Mastercard holding a 30% global share of all payment processing outside of China, this is no small change. We are already seeing these changes disrupt the industry as thousands of videos are being deleted that do not comply with Mastercard's regulations.

Mastercard's policies are setting a desperately-needed new standard, which will likely uproot and prevent mass amounts of porn that features victims of rape, trafficking, and child sexual abuse.

Major Pornhub competitor, xHamster, starts deleting content

In addition to the major breakthroughs we've gained in holding Mind-Geek and Pornhub accountable, we've seen broader industry changes begin to take place as a powerful ripple effect. A major competitor to Pornhub, xHamster, has implemented significant changes to their website, shifting their entire business model in the same ways Pornhub did after their criminal activity was exposed. The changes include:

- Removing the "download" button
- 2 **Deleting large amounts** of unverified content from the website
- 3 Disallowing anonymous uploaders to upload content to the site

Like Pornhub, xHamster is being investigated for hosting videos of rape, trafficking, revenge porn, and child sexual abuse, and is also being sued by the victims of these crimes.

Roku bans Pornhub and ALL PORN after pressure from Traffickinghub and our allies

In March, Exodus Cry publicly called out the US' number one TV streaming platform, Roku, for hosting a private channel for Pornhub. Thousands of our followers sprung into action, flooding their social media pages and demanding the platform remove the Pornhub channel.

Just months later, in the beginning of November, Roku announced they would ban Pornhub and all other porn channels from their platform, effective March 2022.

Movieguide wrote an article about Roku's decision, sharing Exodus Cry's celebratory Instagram post, saying the change came about "due to added pressure from advocacy groups such as Exodus Cry."





Children today are two clicks away from the most graphic and degrading sex acts imaginable, and it's altering the course of millions of children's lives. Big Porn and Big Tech are responsible. That's why we launched the Protect Children Not Porn campaign, calling for every single porn site to require that users be age verified, with ID, before they can access content.

When children are exposed to porn it undermines their social, emotional, and cognitive development. Repeat exposure can both rewire the brain and shape their sexual templates in ways that could derail their lives. This is why child protection experts view early exposure to porn as a form of child abuse.


Protect Children Not Porn Impacts Millions


The Protect Children Not Porn campaign has made a significant global impact. Its success can be measured in two distinct ways.



outreaches in Kansas City, offering Hope bags and practical resources to women being trafficked and exploited on the streets, in strip clubs, and online. The end goal is always to help them fully exit a life of exploitation in the sex industry so they can rebuild beautiful, healthy new lives.

Our outreach team recently connected with a trafficked woman named Millie and was able to successfully assist her escape from her pimp and place her into a safe home, out of state, where she can heal and rebuild her life.

As we've done in Kansas City, we are beginning to build an outreach team here in Southern California and plan to conduct monthly outreach to women and girls who are exploited in prostitution.

In addition, Exodus Cry will be part of a larger coordinated outreach to exploited women and girls in trafficking hotspots across Los Angeles, during the 2022 NFL Super Bowl. Exodus Cry has conducted outreach around major sporting events worldwide for the past decade and some of our most significant breakthroughs have come about through these outreaches.


